WE RAISE AWARENESS AMONG OUR TEAMS AND CUSTOMERS

- Our environmental manager is trained in sustainable tourism, environmental preservation and CSR issues.
- All our teams are aware of eco-friendly practices and trained to apply them in their daily work.
- We select our service providers and suppliers based on their environmental and social commitments.
- We encourage sustainable transport: provision of bicycles, information on public transport, on-site charging stations for electric vehicles.

WE SAVE WATER AND ENERGY

- We have installed pressure reducers on taps and showers to conserve resources.
- We read our water and electricity meters every month to better manage our consumption.
- We are replacing every light bulb with an LED or low-energy bulb and have already equipped more than 75% of our lighting.
- Motion detectors and timers in common areas to avoid wasting energy.

WE LIMIT AND SORT WASTE

- We have set up several accessible and clearly marked recycling points on each floor of the hotel.
- Disposable tableware has been eliminated and reusable tableware is now provided.
- We work with a majority of bulk or large-packaged products to limit unnecessary packaging.
- In order to reduce waste and packaging, we only offer welcome products on request.











- We have put up signs to help our guests sort their waste in accordance with local regulations.
- Gradual digitisation of our media: electronic invoices, QR codes with information about the hotel, etc.

WE CARE ABOUT THE WELLBEING OF OUR CUSTOMERS

- At the restaurant, we cook with seasonal, local produce and also offer meat-free meals.
- Our cleaning products are eco-labelled.
- For the well-being of our staff and guests, we have banned bleach, which is irritating to the respiratory tract and toxic to aquatic organisms.
- Bed linen, bath towels and beach towels will only be changed when necessary.

- We support the marine protected area of the town of Agde by providing our conference room for an awareness-raising meeting.
- Sale of products to support the Project Rescue Ocean association.
- We give our used furniture and equipment a second life.
